Any information that clearly assigns the sample to the animal named in the accompanying letter (e.g. name, chip number) is suitable as an animal ID.

Order information

The following applies to all sample materials:

One of the following documents must be enclosed with the sample shipment:

- copy or note of the order number of the associated online order, or
- accompanying letter with precise details of the sender, the animal and the tests to be carried out, or
- completed order form from the breeding association, or
- generatio order form
